- We serve lunch at the Fallout level of First Presbyterian Church, 1820 15th Street in Boulder. You can pay and park on streets surrounding the church, or park for free in the city parking lots. If there is parking available at the church feel free to park there.
- Leave personal belongings at home or locked in your car. We don't have much room for storage. Do not bring money, so you are not tempted to give it out to someone in need. If money or other requests are made, then find a leader and they may have referral services for the needs of our guests (such as EFFA, Boulder County Cares, Homeless Shelter).
- The Saturday schedule is as follows:

Early cookers arrive 9:00 am
Bible Study for Guests 10:00-11:30 pm
Music/Message/Prayer 11:30-12:00 pm

Meal Served 12:00-1:00 pm
Clean up 1:00-2:30 pm

 You will be welcome to share in the meal if there is enough food and after guests have been served. Please join the guests at a table if you feel comfortable.
